1. GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS

The Slovak Abilitysport Youth Games are organized by the **Slovak Sports Association for the Disabled** which is the national body of physically disabled sports in Slovakia a member of the **Slovak Paralympic Committee** and member of international sports organizations **World Abilitysport, BISFed, IWBF, World ParaVolley**.

The games introduce a new format of sporting event, providing young and novice athletes with a space for competition and healthy sports confrontation. In 2022 and 2023, the games took place at the national level with last year hosting nearly 100 participants across 7 sports. The hometown of the games is Dolný Kubín a city located in a beautiful natural environment with adequate sports infrastructure and strong organizational support.

The event dates are **September 12-15, 2024** immediately following the end of the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games, offering an ideal opportunity to motivate young and novice athletes as the program will include a meeting with successful Slovak Paralympians. The games are held with the knowledge and consent of the international organization World Abilitysport.

Participants: Athletes aged **10-26 years** according to the age categories of individual sports. For age assessment, the athlete's age reached by **December 31 of the year of the games is relevant.** Competition experience is not required.

Sports: **Athletics, Archery, Boccia, Cycling, Swimming, Table Tennis**
One participant can start in a **maximum of two sports.**
The number of disciplines is not limited.
Starts must not conflict with the competition schedule.

Entry Deadline: **2nd Entry**—mandatory registrations by **July 29, 2024**

2nd Entry form is included.

Categories:

Age and classification categories are individually defined for each sport (information on individual sports on pages 11-18). Athletes without classification will be classified for the purposes of the competition (the national classifier will assign a one-time classification before the competition).

50 € per person (it includes accommodation and fullboard)

6. SPORTS—ATHLETICS

AGE CATEGORIES:

U14—combined boys + girls 11-13 years

U17—boys, girls 14-16 years

U20—boys, girls 17-19 years

U23—boys, girls 20-22 years

DEVELOPMENT—men, women - novice athletes and athletes after injury aged 23-26 years

CLASSIFICATION CATEGORIES:

STANDING:

T35-38 - coordination disorders (hypertonia, ataxia, and athetosis)

T40-41 - short stature

T42-44 - lower limb impairment (amputation in competition without prosthesis, differences in length, reduced muscle strength or impaired range of motion)

T45-47 - upper limb impairment (amputation, reduced muscle strength or impaired range of motion)

T61-64 – lower limb impairment (amputation with prosthesis, or difference in length of limb in competition with prosthesis)

WHEELCHAIRS:

T32-34 - coordination disorders (hypertonia, ataxia, and athetosis)

T51-57 – amputation, reduced muscle strength or impaired range of motion





SPORTS DISCIPLINES:

60 meters - U14

100 meters - U17, U20, U23, DEVELOPMENT

300 meters—U14

1500 meters—U17, U20, U23, DEVELOPMENT

Standing long jump—all age categories

Wheelchair club throw—all age categories

Standing cricket ball throw—U14

OTHER PROVISIONS:

- Starts of individual disciplines according to the schedule.
- Competitors must start in appropriate sports clothing.
- Spikes shoes are not mandatory.
- Competitors will be assigned start numbers, which must be visibly placed.
- The organizer may adjust the competition by merging age and classification groups based on the number of registered participants.



SPORTS—ARCHERY

AGE CATEGORIES:

U12—mixed boys + girls aged 10-12

U14—boys, girls aged 13-14

U17—boys, girls aged 15-17

U19—boys, girls aged 18-19

U21 + DEVELOPMENT—mixed boys, girls aged 20-21 + novice athletes and athletes after injury aged 22-26 (men, women)

CLASSIFICATION CATEGORIES:

Wheelchair W1+W2

Standing

Open—novice archers without competitive experience

OTHER PROVISIONS:

- Divisions according to World Archery rules - **recurve bow, compound bow.**
- Competition setups: U12—30m (target 122 cm), U14—30m (target 80 cm), U17 girls—50m (target 122 cm), U17 boys, U19, U21, DEVELOPMENT—50m (target 80 cm), OPEN—10m (80 cm).
- The organizer may adjust the competition by merging age and classification groups based on the number of registered participants.





SPORTS—BOCCIA

AGE CATEGORIES:

U14—combined boys + girls 10-14 years

U23 + DEVELOPMENT—combined boys + girls 15-23 years + novice athletes and athletes after injury aged 24-26 years (combined men + women).

CLASSIFICATION CATEGORIES:

BC1

OTHER PROVISIONS:

- Individual Competition—group phase + elimination phase, according to the valid rules of World Boccia.
- If there are enough participants, there will also be competitions for BC1-2 teams and BC4-5 pairs.
- The organizer may adjust the competition by merging age and classification groups based on the number of registered participants.
- The number of participants in one competition category is limited to max. 8.

U23+DEVELOPMENT —boys, girls 15-23 years
+ athletes after injury aged 24-26 years (men,
women)

OTHER PROVISIONS:

- 6 km time trial—urban circuit with finish at the athletic stadium.
- Helmet required in all categories.
- H and T groups must use a safety bar.
- The organizer may adjust the competition by merging classification categories based on the number of registered participants.

SPORTS DISCIPLINES:

25 meters freestyle

50 meters freestyle, breaststroke, butterfly, backstroke

100 meters freestyle, breaststroke, butterfly, backstroke

100 meters individual medley

150 meters individual medley (SM1-4)

OTHER PROVISIONS:

- 25m pool with electronic timing, according to current World Para Swimming rules.
- Two blocks, heats only.
- The ranking in each discipline will be determined by the points calculation of German Paralympic Swimming, all classification and age categories together.
- The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants to fulfill the competition schedule.



SPORTS—TABLE TENNIS

AGE CATEGORIES:

U21—boys, girls aged 10-21

DEVELOPMENT—22-26 years old athletes and athletes after injury (men, women)

CLASSIFICATION CATEGORIES:

Combined wheelchair TT1-5

Combined TT6-10

OTHER PROVISIONS:

- Doubles competition according to current ITTF rules.
- Group stage + knockout stage.
- The organizer may adjust the competition by merging age and classification categories based on the number of registered participants.

- The schedule may be modified depending on the number of registered participants.
